SEVENTH FRAMEWORK PROGRAMME

Eligibility criteria for the teams of innovators

- Team of innovators must consist out of at least one European (member of the EU or associated country) partner and one Chinese partner. Teams do not need to have an equal number of European and Chinese partner in the team.
- 2. Eligible partners include **research technology development (RTD) organizations**, **companies** (in particular SMEs are encouraged to participate) or **public organizations**.

Eligibility criteria for the presented innovation

- 3. The innovation to be evaluated should be a result of a research or business cooperation, a specific product, process(es), and/or technology(ies) entailing novelties or improvements going beyond of the state-of-the-art.
- 4. The innovation presented must have **industrial relevance** (e.g. in form of an industry relevant topic or in form of the participation of an industrial partner).
- 5. The innovation presented can be a result of an on-going project (running since at least 6 months). Finalized projects are also eligible.
- 6. The innovation must be unique and cannot be submitted twice by different applicants.
- A Letter of Commitment has to be signed by the contestant. The contestant will confirm his/her interest to participate in the award and that in case of nomination among the three finalists, the contestant intends to present (in English) his/her Chinese-European innovation during the EU-China S&T Forum (2015 in Brussels).

All teams of innovators shall comply with these criteria in order be eligible for the second step of the selection process.
